Leven is also home to one of the largest grain distillery and bottling facilities in the world. The property is located in a prominent corner trading location at the junction of Durie Street and Mitchell Street, a continuation of the High Street.

Nearby occupiers include Boots the Chemist, Greggs, Specsavers and a newly opened Costa Coffee.

Heritable (Scottish equivalent of English freehold).


