

Acuitus Terms & Conditions for Online Auctions

- These terms and conditions apply to You and You will be bound by them if You bid
- 2. Definitions used in these terms & conditions:

Acuitus means Acuitus Limited (company registration number 7105769)

Approved Financial Institution has the same meaning as in the RICS Common Auction Conditions Edition 4.0 November 2018.

Auction means the Acuitus online auction to be held at the time and on the date advertised on the Acuitus website in which the **Lot** appears.

Auctioneer means the Acuitus auctioneer having conduct of the Auction.

Bidder means the party bidding for the **Lot** and who acts as agent for the Buyer and guarantees the performance of the Buyer under the **Conditions of Sale**.

Business days means any day except (a) Saturday or Sunday or (b) a bank or public holiday in England and Wales

Buyer means the person, firm or company identified on the Registration Form who agrees to buy the **Lot**.

Conditions of sale means the auction conduct conditions together with the general conditions of sale, any special conditions of sale and any addenda that are applicable and/or relevant to the Lot. Lot means the property for which you bid and bearing the number for which you have entered on the Registration Form.

Price means the price (exclusive of VAT) that the **Buyer** agrees to pay for the **lot**

Registration form means the registration form for remote bidding on the Acuitus website at www.acuitus.co.uk.

Seller means the person selling the lot.

You and **Your** means the person identified on the Registration Form as the bidder being someone who bids by the internet.

VAT means value added tax or any other tax of a similar nature.

3. Registration form

- a. If You wish to bid at the Auction You must complete the Registration Form entering Your full details as the Bidder and full details of the Buyer if different to the Bidder. You must provide details of the conveyancer acting for the bBuyer and the bank account details from which the deposit will be paid
 - You should sign the Registration Form where indicated.
- b. The completed Registration Form should be submitted to Acuitus so that it is received not less than two clear Business Days prior to the date of the Auction, together with: Two forms of identification for You consisting firstly Your passport or current driving licence and secondly proof of Your address such as a recent utility bill or bank statement.
- c. To comply with the Money Laundering Regulations, if You are not the Buyer we will require You to provide further documentation for the Buyer and beneficial owners.
- d. A separate **Registration Form** much be completed for each **Lot**
- e. If You wish to alter any of the details appearing on the Registration Form, You must notify the Auctioneer of this in writing before the Auction commences. Alterations will only be effective if the Auctioneer confirms to You in writing that the request to alter has been received.
- f. In the event that the Auctioneer considers that there is any error or confusion about the registration form or the deposit or the documentation submitted under the Money Laundering Regulations, the Auctioneer reserves the right

- not to accept **Your** bid. Please note that the **Auctioneer's** decision as to what constitutes error or confusion is final.
- g. By completing the **Registration Form You** warrant that there are adequate funds in the account to meet the full amount of the deposit

4. Deposit

The deposit is to be paid immediately after the **auction** and no later than 15:30 on the day following the **Auction** by bank transfer to **Acuitus's** client's account in sterling on an **Approved Financial Institution** for a sum representing the greater of:

a.The minimum deposit of £5,000 (or the total of the **Price** if this is less than that minimum) and

b.10% of the Price

If **You** are the successful bidder **Acuitus** requires a separate payment of £1,500 +VAT as a buyer's administration charge payable to **Acuitus** to be electronically transferred immediately after the **Auction** and no later than 15:30 on the day following the **Auction**.

A VAT receipt will be provided upon receipt of payment.

5. Terms of sale/conduct of Auction

- a. You shall be deemed to have read the Acuitus Common Auction Conditions, the special conditions of sale and any addendum relating to the Lot. You shall be deemed to have taken all necessary professional and legal advice and to have made all Your enquiries.
- b. It is possible that at any time up to the commencement of bidding at the Auction amendments and/or additions may be made to the Conditions of Sale for the Lot or any other matters relating to it. Such amendments are published by means of written addenda. You will be deemed to have knowledge of such matters and if Your bid is successful You will buy subject to them.
- c. If Your bid is successful the Auctioneer or any person authorised by the Auctioneer will sign the Sale Memorandum and any other relevant document relating to the Lot on Your behalf and as soon as the deposit is cleared send this to You.

6. Disclaimer

Acuitus or any employee or agent of **Acuitus** or the **Auctioneer** will have no liability or responsibility whatsoever towards **You** or the **Buyer** in the event of **Your** bid not being made as a result of:

- Unclear instructions.
- Error, lack of clarity or confusion whether during the **Auction** or regarding the **Registration Form** or the deposit.
- Any change in the date, time and/or venue of the **Auction**.
- Any interruption or suspension of internet bidding services.
- \bullet You being unobtainable or becoming disconnected during the course of bidding via the internet. \bullet

Any other factor beyond **Acuitus'** control.

7. Next steps

Please complete the online **Registration Form** and submit it to **Acuitus** no later than one **Business Day** prior to the date of the **Auction**. You will need to receive written confirm from **Acuitus** that **Your** registration to bid has been completed successfully and that **You** are registered to bid.
